

Growth Factors Complex is a concentrated complex of plant origin rich in glutamine, vitamin B9 and cellular growth factors: IGF-1, EGF, aFGF, bFGF and VEGF. Growth factors are proteins that are important for the processes of cell growth, division and differentiation. They bind to receptors on the cell surface, which initiates a number of reactions that influence the cellular response. The complex has a synergistic effect, stimulating the regeneration of both epidermis and dermis cells. It activates repair processes, has anti-aging properties, improves facial contours and helps keep the skin looking young for longer. Moreover, it strengthens capillaries, stimulates the angiogenesis process [1], reduces wrinkles, stimulates collagen synthesis and accelerates the wound healing process [2,3]. Due to their broad spectrum of effects, growth factors are perfect for therapies that reduce scars, stretch marks, discolorations and symptoms of photoaging.

### technology

- 1. Add the ingredients of phase A and the premix of the ingredients of phase B to the main container, heat to 80°C and mix until a smooth mass is obtained
- Dissolve the ingredients of phase C in the auxiliary container at 80°C
- Add the ingredients prepared in item 2 to the main container and start homogenization.
- 4. Cool below 40°C, introduce the ingredients of phase D and mix.
